

LEGO PROGRAM YOUTH WORKERS

Lakeshore School Division invites applications for LEGO Program Youth Worker/Site Supervisor positions. The LEGO (Lakeshore Educational Growth Opportunities) program is an alternative educational program that links youth who have employment barriers to work opportunities. Groups of 8 participants will stay at a camp facility in the Winnipeg area while gaining on the job work experience.

This position requires strong interpersonal abilities and a passion for equipping young adults with the skills that they need to gain employment and live independently. The successful candidate will be professional, dedicated, and adaptable to the changing needs of the program. Previous experience working with youth is required and a preference will be given to individuals with a degree in a related field, a class 2 driver's license (or willingness to obtain a class 2 driver's license), and access to a reliable personal vehicle.

Salary: \$1100/week for 11 weeks pending final grant approval

Start Date: September 18, 2023 **End Date:** December 08, 2023

Responsibilities include:

- Planning and implementing evening programing.
- Transporting participants to their work experience placements.
- Mentoring participants on a day-to-day basis concerning work placements.
- Mentoring participants towards independent living through role modeling <u>while staying</u> overnight at the same camp facility near Winnipeg.
- Creating a positive group atmosphere and resolving conflict.
- Ensuring that participants are following School Division, camp, and employer policies.
- Planning and preparing meals with the participants.
