4.0. EMERGENCY USE OF SCHOOL DIVISION ASSETS

Adopted: December 16, 2003

Lakeshore School Division will cooperate to the greatest extent reasonably possible to provide school bus(es) and facilities in the event of an emergency when requested by the Emergency Coordinator for the Province of Manitoba or a Rural Municipality (within Lakeshore School Division).

The Superintendent and Board will be made aware of all provided emergency services as soon as it is practical.

The needs of the students and staff must be met prior to committing facilities or other assets to anyone.

Alternate arrangements for students and staff may be arranged with prior approval of the Superintendent or designate.

The Superintendent may authorize the Director of Operations & Infrastructure to approve the use of school buses for emergency use, and facilities, when they are unoccupied, i.e. summer months.

Records shall be kept for all asset use and repairs. Associated costs will be recovered from the authority requesting use of the assets.
