SAFETY REMINDER: Administering medicine

Prescribed medication can be administered by the school secretary or principal.

To do so, the medicine ***MUST be brought into the school office*** by the caregiver, with a signed form detailing the name of the medicine, dosage and times (see attached sheet).

For the safety of your child, and others, PLEASE DO NOT send prescribed medicine or open over the counter Tylenol and /or Advil with your child in their backpack or lunch kit. This division policy is in place to keep your child, and others, **safe from ingesting medicine.**

2026-2027 School Supplies

Each year the school purchases bulk classroom supplies, though going forward, we will no longer continue with this.

Teachers often use their money to purchase the yearly supplies and then get reimbursed. When supplies are not paid, the school needs to take funds from fundraising (that often pays for the cost of field trips and additional school activities) to pay for the outstanding supply fees. We are now in a substantiable deficit due to outstanding school fees.
