Co-ed Hockey Academy Pilot Program Application 2025-2026

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

After a successful pilot program at the Eriksdale Hockey Academy, Lakeshore School Division has decided to extend this program to grades 5 - 8. We will be opening to applications for students in grades 5 through 8. This form or the online form is the formal application to enroll your student in the middle years' hockey academy.

The **deadline to submit this application for the hockey academy is March 27th, 2025**. This form can be returned to either Lundar School, Eriksdale School, completed in the online Forms version or emailed to tozelas@lakeshoresd.mb.ca.

There will be a supply cost associated with acceptance into the hockey academy program that will cover the costs associated with the program that are in addition to regular school programming. Please note the cost associated with this program is non-refundable. The cost last year was \$700.00 for the year, this year there will be a slight increase, but we are unsure yet if that will be \$50 or \$100.

This academy will continue looking for grants and sponsorship to help keep fees as affordable as possible. If your child is passionate about hockey and would like to enroll in our program but you are experiencing barriers to enrollment, please reach out as there are numerous government and non-profit programs available to help with the costs associated with youth sport participation in Canada. Eriksdale Hockey Academy Application

This is a comprehensive hockey academy that will include approximately 75-100 hours of on-ice physical education. On the ice students will work on skating, shooting, passing, puck control, dryland training, and other aspects of skill development associated with hockey. Off the ice, students will be learning the same academics that they would receive in a regular school setting. Following the removal of the ice from the Lundar Arena, students will participate in other local sports such as baseball, golf, and more, to ensure multi-sport participation.

Students interested in enrolling in this academy should have some skating ability and will need to have all the necessary hockey equipment as required when playing minor hockey.

Parents/caregivers of students enrolled in the academy will also have the option to choose if they would like to set up an account at Pembina Source for Sports. Pembina Source for Sports is the Lundar Falcons Jr Hockey Club equipment supplier and will allow hockey academy students to have the same discount that Lundar Falcons' players get on equipment. Signing up for an account is voluntary and there is no cost to set up an account. This supplier has both new and used equipment and they deliver to Lundar from September until the end of the Junior B hockey season. This option is available to help reduce the costs associated with sports equipment that is required to join the academy.

Parents, caregivers, and students should be aware of the commitment associated with being on the ice this often as well as being a part of a hockey academy. This program will maintain high expectations for students both on and off the ice. Students not following the rules of the academy may miss ice times if rules and expectations are not met. In addition, due to the offsite nature of this program, students who are not able to meet the ongoing expectations of this program may be removed from the hockey academy. There is limited space available in this program, not all students who apply may be admitted into the hockey academy. Parents/caregivers and students will both be given a hockey academy student agreement to sign prior to the start of the academy that will include both Eriksdale School rules and the Hockey Academy rules.
