Administering Medication

If a student requires medication during school hours, this will be the responsibility of the principal and/or designate, subject to the following procedures:

- ⇒ Written authorization stating the child's name, the name of the drug, the time it is to be administered and any possible side effect (*form is available at the school*).
- ⇒ Any medication sent to school must be given to the teacher immediately upon arrival, and must be in its original container.
- ⇒ Medication is stored in a safe place in the school by the principal or designate.

Please be reminded, we are an 'Allergy Aware' school. **DO NOT** send fish, nuts or peanut butter to school with your child.
